Home Learning Support: Information for Parents and Carers

Key Skills Pack

The 'Key Skills Pack' covers some of the basic skills your child works on at school. This includes skills and activity ideas appropriate to your child's learning pathway and can be found the home learning section of the Rowan School website.

Don't feel that you need to cover all of the activities in the Key Skills Pack, particularly if your child is feeling unwell. You can choose the activities that work for you and your family.

Online learning

<u>'Twinkl Go'</u> is an online learning platform with access to educational games and activities. These online games and activities are free to access and the instructions about how to use Twinkl Go can be found in the home learning section of the <u>Rowan School website</u>. Your child's teacher will provide you with a code to access educational activities that are appropriate to your child's learning pathway.
